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Location

The Malabar House is in the heart of historical Fort Cochin, opposite St. Francis church and 3 minutes' walk to the Chinese fishing nets.

Accessibility

By air Cochin International airport gets daily flights from all major metros, Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Hyderabad, Bangalore, Trivandrum, Calicut, Trichy and International flights via Dubai, Doha, Kuwait, Muscat, Bahrain, Abu Dhabi, Jeddah, Sharjah, Riyadh. International flights from Asia connect via Male, Colombo, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok.

By train Ernakulam Junction South and North connected to all major cities in India, and Kerala.

By road Follow NH47 Highway till Ernakulam and onwards to Fort Kochi.

Frequent comfortable bus connections are available from southern state capitals which stop at Ernakulam.

Transfer

The Malabar House arranges transfers by taxi to and from the airport & railway station. Time to airport is 1 hour 30 minutes for 45 Km, to station 30 minutes, 12 Km.

Divine's extended terrace is an ideal seat out overlooking the patio and hotel exteriors for those who love open air.

Facilities All 17 rooms are centrally air-conditioned with attached bathrooms. The rooms have stone floors, no rugs and are decorated superbly with stunning colour schemes, antique & contemporary objects d'art. All rooms have large bathrooms with bathtub and shower facilities, hanging space, televisions, direct dial telephones, WIFI, safe deposit lockers, coffee makers and minibar. All rooms have dedicated verandas, terraces or private garden sit outs, while the suites have private terraces. There are no interconnecting rooms but some rooms can be booked adjacent to each other. Purespa, the concept of Purespa is a fusion of invigorating traditional Ayurveda therapies and specialized oil massages. India has developed over the centuries its own system of Ayurvedic oil massages. Purespa offers a wellness journey of distinct massages & rejuvenation to relax, detox and enhance beauty. Other treatments like manicure & pedicure are offered on request.

Purespa is located in the first and second floor of the central court yard building, consisting of 2 massage rooms in the first floor, a twin massage room on the second floor, bathroom & shower available. **Purespa** offers a dedicated spa menu for an intimate and cocooning massage experience.

Yoga session is offered daily between 7.30 and 8.30 am at the Cochin Club, fees will be charged per person. Additional individual or group classes can be arranged within the Hotel premises in consultation with the front desk.

Accommodation

Comprises 17 rooms categorized as Deluxe, Roof Garden Suites and The Malabar Suite.

1 Malabar Suite Double #18 a very peaceful maisonette, situated on the first floor towards the patio's building.

It comprises a sitting room downstairs and an upstairs bedroom, bathroom and private terrace.

5 Roof Garden Suites Double #9, 10, 11, 12, 17, all suites are located on the first floor of the building, the rooms are large and comprises of public terraces, private terraces and balconies.

6 Double Deluxe rooms #1 D, 6 D, 7 D, 14 D, 15 D, 16 D on the ground floor.

5 Twin Deluxe rooms #2 T, 3 T, 4 T, 5 T & 8 T on the ground floor.

Room numbers # 9 D, 10 D, 11 D & 12 D overlooking the historic Parade ground # 17 D & 18 D have own terraces.

Room numbers # 1 D, 6 D, 7 D, 8 T, 14 D & 15 D have their own garden with private sit out.

Room numbers # 2 T, 3 T, 4 T, 6 D & 16 D have terraced sit outs.

Opening and closing The Malabar House operates in all 365 days.

Room Service is available from 7.00 till 23.00

Garden dining Meals, snacks and drinks can be served in the garden by the swimming pool. At the stage Classic Carnatic South Indian music & dances are performed during the evening dinner time, subject to weather conditions.

Meal times Breakfast 07.00 to 10.00 | Lunch 12.30 to 15.00 | Dinner 19.00 to 23.00 This is only a guideline as meal times are not strictly imposed

Divine wine lounge timing The wine lounge is open daily from 11.00 to 23.00 Following the state liquor policy every 1st of the month is a dry day. Some of the notified public holidays are also prescribed as dry days.

Dress code There is no official dress code at **The Malabar House**. However, you may wish to change into smart casual for dinner.

Children The Malabar House accepts children of all ages. Children may be accommodated in their parent's bedroom for an extra charge. Only one additional child per room is permitted. Babysitting can be arranged on prior notice. Children are welcome but, being a small and peaceful place; guests are asked to be aware that noise carries here! The Malabar House swimming pool has a maximum depth of 1.25 m. however vigilance is required for children that cannot swim.

Check in 2 pm and Check out 12 noon Extended check in - check out time is subject to availability.

Others Electricity 220 volts. The standard two round pin adaptors work.

Credit cards - currency The Malabar House accepts American Express, Visa, and Master Card. In case of payments in foreign currency, the hotel accepts US dollars, Pounds Sterling and Euros.

Mobile telephones All mobile telephones work on local networks.

When to go / Climate There are no major seasonal weather changes in Kerala as it benefits from a tropical climate and is warm & humid all year round. No warm clothes are necessary in Cochin. It tends to rain in June and July and there can be sporadic showers in October and November.

Pests Being a coastal, tropical area, there are mosquitoes. However, the hotel takes precautions by way of pest control; it sprays the public areas and gardens daily. The rooms have mosquito repellents, mosquito nets on request are also provided and anti mosquito spray is available for added protection when dining outside. Occasionally we do have birds approaching the garden or terraces areas where food is served; we recommend that you do not encourage them by giving food.

Sightseeing & tours can be arranged by the hotel reception.

Excursions & activities The Malabar House with the walking map of Fort Cochin which takes you on a gentle stroll around the area, indicating key buildings, churches of historical value & the Chinese fishing nets. Indo-Portuguese Museum, Naval Museum, this walk can be done at any time, on your own and without the services of a pre-arranged guide. However, local guides can be arranged if required.
